

# Young People

## The Issues:

The provision of services to young people in Steeton and Eastburn.

## Background

1) The young people of the parish should be given the opportunity to be fully involved in the life of their community. Their wants, needs and aspirations need to be recognized.

2) At present there is a thriving cricket and football club for all ages in Steeton. For 7 – 13 year olds there is a youth club which meets fortnightly at the Methodist Chapel.

3) There is very little for young people who are not actively involved in sport and over the age of 11. The only place provided to meet is the shelter in the Keighley Road Recreation Ground.

4) The questionnaire identified a need for a parish focal point.

5) There have been reports of youth nuisance throughout the parish with associated problems of noise and litter.
