## Community First Responder Scheme—could you help?

Yorkshire Ambulance Service (YAS) is looking for volunteers in Steeton, and Eastburn and the surrounding areas to join its Community First Responder scheme. Community First Responders are volunteers who provide immediate life-saving care to members of their local communities in an emergency medical situation, such as heart attack, breathing difficulties or a collapse, in the vital minutes before the ambulance arrives.

They are trained in Cardio Pulmonary Resuscitation (CPR) and the use of an Automatic External Defibrillator (AED) which delivers a controlled electric shock to restart the heart. First Responders also carry portable oxygen. Dave Jones, Community Defibrillation Officer for YAS in West Yorkshire, said: “Community First Responders make a valuable contribution to their communities. We know that in many medical emergencies the first few minutes are critical. If effective treatment can be performed within those first minutes, lives can be saved and disability reduced. Being a First Responder can be extremely rewarding and I would encourage anyone who may be interested in taking on the role to get in touch. “Many people volunteer as a Community First Responder to gain experience, to help their local communities and some people have had personal experience of a loved one needing prompt medical attention and can see the value in this initiative. Volunteers come from all walks of life.”



Full training is given to successful applicants who need to be over 18, physically fit and hold a full driving licence having never been banned from driving with no more than three penalty points. Yorkshire Ambulance Service will also run Enhanced Disclosure and Barring Service (DBS) checks on candidates. If there is sufficient interest from people in Steeton and Eastburn a training course will be run at the HUB in Steeton, supported by Steeton-with-Eastburn Parish Council. ## Memorial Garden Frontage

As residents may be aware BMDC are intending to withdraw from putting bedding plants in flower beds around the district. They are proposing to plant up these areas with perennial shrubs. There are concerns large shrubs could potentially pose a safety issue and impact negatively on the Memorial Garden.

What would residents like the Parish Council to do with the area in front of the Memorial Garden?

The options are:-

1. Do nothing and let BMDC continue with the plans they have to put perennials in.
2. The Parish Council takes over the maintenance of this area and award a contract for someone to do this in line with residents wishes.
3. To form a friends group who would then be responsible for the upkeep with support from the Parish Council.

(There may be a small Council Tax rise of 3 pence per week per elector to fund options 2 and 3).
