1. Apologies:

No apologies for absence were received.

2. Minutes:

The minutes of the Annual Parish Meeting held 2 March 2005 were approved and signed.

3. Chairman's Report:

The Vice-Chairman gave a report on the activities of the council over the last year and thanked all the councillors and the clerk for their hard work over the preceding twelve months.

5. Public questions

- Sight Lines when exiting Sutton Lane: Concerns were expressed regarding the site lines when travelling from Sutton Lane to Main Road, Eastburn. PCSO Blood agreed to monitor the parking on the main road.
- Moor Lane: Reports of a serious dog fouling problem were reported. The clerk will ask the Dog Warden service to patrol the area.
- Switching off of electricity supplies to properties close to Barrows Lane, Steeton. The electricity supply is to be cut off for an extended period at short notice. The clerk will contact YEDL and ask for a more realistic period of interruption in supply.
- Speeding traffic and congestion: The speed of traffic through the villages and the congestion at peak times was a cause for concern. The parish council will continue to press the police for more enforcement activities and consult with highways on congestion issues.
- Parking on Station Road: Concerns were expressed at cars from the railway station obstructing Station Road, Steeton. The parish council will continue to press Highways for a traffic regulation order to prevent parking on Station Road and negotiate with Metro and Northern Rail to improve the parking situation at the railway station.

The Annual Parish Meeting was then followed by a Neighbourhood Forum meeting chaired by Jeff Bennett, Keighley Area Co-Ordinator.
