19/028 Meetings Attended:

Cllr Mullen attended Parish Council liaison meeting on 16 January 2019: Rate support grant to be withdrawn in 2020 (C£2500).

Street cleansing to suffer a 35% cut in funding (mechanical sweepers and staff). Keighley area to meet on 25 February 2019 to discuss gateway routes and cleansing, towards Bradford rather than in this area.

Planet Bradford: Brownfield not being looked at but looking at greenfield sites. Looking at weighting of neighborhood plans. Reviewing CiL with aim to increase it as rural levy is too low.

19/029 Members reports:

Some potholes by AGH have been attended to.

Since addition of filter light at Steeton top lights, left turn from Skipton Rd (towards Keighley) to Station Rd can be difficult for large vehicles.

Pedestrians wishing to cross station road are now experiencing difficulties due to filter light allowing traffic down Station Rd, as there is no proper pedestrian crossing or gap in "green light."

Lamp post obscures sight of new traffic light stand, specifically the filter left turn light.

Pavement from Steeton School to Aireburn Ave is in appalling state.

Ad hoc repairs to inspection cover by 1st bend on Thornhill Rd (opposite Meadow Drive) are inadequate.

Obstructive parking of long vehicles on Steeton Hall gardens by local business.

March 22nd – April 23rd – nationwide litter picking initiative.

Litter bin audit: (CBMDC owned bins) location and condition of each one needs noting with a view to replacing ones that are substandard or not large enough. Send info to chairman.
